Calogena welcomes the signing of a nuclear collaboration agreement between France and Finland

On 20 October in Luxembourg, Finnish Minister of the Environment and Climate Sari Multala and French Minister of the Economy, Finance and Energy Transition Roland Lescure signed a declaration of intent to establish long-term, diversified cooperation between Finland and France in the field of nuclear energy.

The priority areas for cooperation include the construction of small modular nuclear reactors for heat production, strengthening the security of supply of fissile materials and fuels, and developing safe solutions for radioactive waste management.

Calogena welcomes this major initiative, which validates its positioning in nuclear heat production for urban networks. Calogena is currently developing its solution in five cities, three in France and two in Finland. The district heating operators in Helsinki and Kuopio have launched a nuclear heating program.

By clearly positioning itself in export markets, particularly in Finland, Calogena brings with it all of France's nuclear excellence in the service of decarbonization.

Calogena is committed to strengthening nuclear collaboration between France and Finland.
